

## **Localised Digital and Telehealth Interfaces**

#### **Supported Telehealth Services**

Utilisation of clinical decision tools and resources, using Healthdirect and Healthpathways to link to multidisciplinary teams of telehealth providers willing to deliver services required with follow up face to face available if required.

Wifi capabilities for patients to access digital health apps and services on their devices while attending the Goondiwindi, Toomelah and Boggabilla clinics to review My Health Record, Health apps, etc.



## **Cross Border Data Sharing**

#### Patient data shared across Qld and NSW Health jurisdictions

To improve continuity of care across Queensland and NSW Health jurisdictions a model of patient consent and data sharing between Hospitals, Rural Health Clinics, ACCHOs and GPs will be established.
