

Supporting Residential Aged Care Homes



- Facilitating connections with GPs and allied health professionals supporting residents to receive regular, proactive primary care services including care planning.
- Supporting residential aged care homes with COVID-19 vaccinations



- Conducting tailored education and training sessions for aged care and primary healthcare staff.
- Enhancing clinical skills and knowledge to improve resident care outcomes.



- Providing robust after-hours support systems for urgent care needs.
- Ensuring continuity of care outside regular business hours.



- Implementation of digital health tools for efficient resident care.
- Connection to the My Health Record system to streamline information sharing between healthcare provider organisations involved in residents' care.



- Access to telehealth services for remote consultations and specialist support.
- Enhancing accessibility to healthcare professionals for residents.



• Offering psychotherapeutic support services for residents' mental wellbeing.



- Commissioning specialist palliative support and hospital substitution for older people who live in RACHs (West Moreton region).
- Enhancing palliative care coordination and integration to support individuals with known life-limiting conditions.



- The PHN advocates for a systematic approach to enhance awareness, access to information, and advice on dementia, as well as support services available within the community.
- Developing localised resources for the community and professionals via GP Health Pathways and Dementia Peak bodies.
- Supporting the delivery of educational and awareness activities for both professionals and the community.
- Providing support to address local challenges and promote early detection for individuals experiencing dementia.
