Who is Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN?

- We are funded by the Australian Government to improve primary health care services (services that sit outside of a hospital) in the Darling Downs and West Moreton region.
- To do this, we work with the community and health care providers to identify the services that are needed the most, and then we fund services based on these needs.

What is **`TALK ABOUT**'?

- TALK ABOUT is a way for Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN to ask you about your experience with healthcare in your community.
- We want to TALK ABOUT what you think is working well and what you think could be done better.
- Throughout 2024, we will have four topics for you to give feedback on.
- We want to TALK ABOUT 'Preventative Health and Chronic Conditions'.
- The survey for the 'Preventative Health and Chronic Conditions' topic will be open until Monday, 9 December 2024.
