Who is Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN?

- We are funded by the Australian Government to improve primary health care services (services that sit outside of a hospital) in the Darling Downs and West Moreton region.
- To do this, we work with the community and health care providers to identify the services that are needed the most, and then we fund services based on these needs.

What is 'TALK ABOUT'?

- TALK ABOUT is a way for Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN to ask you about your experience with healthcare in your community.
- We want to TALK ABOUT what you think is working well and what you think could be done better.
- Throughout 2025, we will have four topics for you to give feedback on.
- We want to TALK ABOUT 'Primary Care Workforce'.
- The survey for the 'Primary Care Workforce' topic will be open from Monday, 3 March 202 to Monday, 14 April 2025.

What will the PHN do with the information?

• The PHN will use the information you provide to inform our Health Needs Assessment (HNA) document.

- The HNA is our guiding document for making decisions about what services we fund in our region, and where we fund them.
- Your information will help us with forward planning for future services in our region.

What about my privacy?

- Your responses will be confidential and we do not collect identifying information such as your name or email address.
- All data is stored in a password protected electronic format.
- Your responses will be used to provide aggregate data about health services in the region, including a summary of the sentiments of people who used these services, for planning and reporting purposes by the Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN.
